How much does electricity cost in Serbia?

The average price of electricity in Serbia, in June of 2024, has been 0.1082 EUR per kilowatt hour. Electricity price has increased EUR 0.0036 kWh, 3.44% since the previous semester. Meanwhile, the average price of electricity without taxes in Serbia in that period was EUR 0.0783 per kilowatt hour, compared to EUR 0.0755 kWh in the previous semester.

How much electricity is consumed in Serbia in 2022?

Traded volumes on the day-ahead market were increasing and resulted in 10,5 TWh in 2022. This amounts to over 30% of final electricity consumption. The state-owned company producer and supplier Elektroprivreda Srbije (EPS) continues to be a dominant player in the Serbian electricity market.

Why are electricity prices so high in winter in Serbia?

If, on the other hand, the production of electricity is small and demand is high, prices will increase. Therefore, the price of electricity is often highest in winter, as the need for electricity for heating is highest. Electricity spot prices in Serbia today, hour by hour.
