The largest component of utility-scale battery storage costs lies in the battery cells themselves, typically accounting for 30-40% of total system costs. In the European market, lithium-ion batteries currently range from EUR200 to EUR300 per kilowatt-hour (kWh), with prices continuing to decrease as manufacturing scales up and technology improves.

How much does battery maintenance cost?

This collaborative approach has accelerated manufacturing improvements and cost reductions. Current projections indicate that utility-scale battery storage costs will continue to decrease by 8-10% annually through 2030, driven by increased production volumes and ongoing technological innovations.
