For larger applications, commercial-grade systems (20+kWh) start at EUR15,000 and can exceed EUR30,000 depending on capacity and features. The lifespan of these units typically ranges from 10-15 years, with warranties covering 10 years or 10,000 cycles.

How much does battery storage cost?

The largest component of utility-scale battery storage costs lies in the battery cells themselves, typically accounting for 30-40% of total system costs.
