Learn more Household electricity prices in Mexico amounted to 11 U.S. dollar cents per kilowatt-hour in December 2024. Residential electricity prices have increased steadily in the country since the end of 2020, when they were at 8.2 U.S. dollar cents per kilowatt-hour.

Since 2017, the average electricity price in Mexico has fluctuated between 111.14 USD/MWh (2017) and 151.60 USD/MWh (2023). The top amount of capacity installed in Mexico in 2023 was in Natural Gas at 47.72%, down from 48.89% in 2022.
