



# Can i use solar batteries in my camera

Can a solar panel mount charge a camera?

Yes,as long as your camera receives adequate power from the Solar Panel Mount it will have full functionality,exactly the same as when it's powered by the camera's 2 AA 1.5 volt batteries. It is important; however,to keep functional batteries in your camera,in case your solar panel battery has no charge.

Does a solar panel extend the battery life of a blink camera?

No,the Solar Panel simply provides external power to your Blink Outdoor (3rd Gen) Camera,which may extend the life of your camera's batteries. What kind of battery is used in the Blink Solar Panel Mount? The Solar Panel uses one 18650 Lithium-Ion rechargeable battery.

How do I power a trail camera with a solar panel?

Simply use the power cord from the solar panel and plug it into the auxiliary port(AUX) that is typically located at the bottom of your trail camera. I recommend still installing the camera's recommended batteries. These will be used as a back up in the event that the solar panel is not able to produce enough solar energy.

How do I connect my camera to a solar panel?

First remove the pull-tab in the battery compartment to activate the battery. Next,you simply plug the camera in via the Micro-USB cord,then snap the camera onto the mount. After a few minutes,the camera will then be able to access the rechargeable battery built into the solar panel. [Click here for detailed setup instructions.](#)

Should you use solar for DSLR charging?

Do trail cameras need a solar panel?

With a solar panel, you will have virtually unlimited battery life, and only need to go into the camera location when you want to move it. If you use your trail cameras in areas out of town, in a different state, or miles back into a swamp, the likelihood of checking the cameras on a regular basis are pretty slim.
