



# Casio wave ceptor solar battery replacement

Are Casio WaveCeptor watches rechargeable?

Casio Waveceptor watches are self-setting, radio-controlled timepieces that use a small solar panel and rechargeable battery to make frequent battery changes a thing of the past. Though rechargeable batteries last much longer than traditional watch batteries, rechargeables can sometimes lose their ability to hold a charge over time.

How do I replace the battery on my Casio WaveCeptor?

Place your Casio Waveceptor facedown on the padded work surface. Short the newly installed rechargeable battery by touching the tips of the metal tweezers to the battery and AC terminal for two seconds. Place the protective white plastic plate over the battery compartment and replace the back cover.

Can you change a rechargeable battery in a Casio WaveCeptor?

Though rechargeable batteries last much longer than traditional watch batteries, rechargeables can sometimes lose their ability to hold a charge over time. Casio recommends that wearers send watches with battery problems to authorised service centres, but daring do-it-yourselfers can change the battery in their Waveceptor at home in just minutes.

How do I update my Casio Wave Ceptor digital watch?

The "D" button on your Casio Wave Ceptor digital watch performs a variety of functions on its own. In Timekeeping mode, the "D" button can be held to initiate a manual watch update. Once started, stop the update at any time by pressing the "D" button. The "D" button is also used to toggle through display screens in the Wave Ceptor's various modes.

Why should you buy a Casio Wave Ceptor watch?

The Casio Wave Ceptor digital and analog wristwatches are equipped with sensors that receive regular updates to ensure that the time displayed on your watch is always correct. Accurate timekeeping and handy features like an alarm, stopwatch and countdown timer make the Casio Wave Ceptor watch a great gift for yourself or another.

What is the C button on a Casio Wave Ceptor watch?

The "C" button on your Casio Wave Ceptor watch is used to scroll through the various modes of the watch. It is also used to advance the flashing when setting the time, data and alarm functions. The "C" button can also be held down in any of the watch's modes to mute or un-mute the watch's hourly chime.
