

# Expected ROI of solar plus storage project in Indonesia 2025

Will Indonesia deploy 100 GW of solar?

The Indonesian government has revealed a new initiative aiming to deploy 100 GW of solar. The distributed solar for energy self-sufficiency program encompasses 80 GW of solar that will be deployed as 1 MW solar arrays with 4 MWh of accompanying battery energy storage systems (BESS).

How much solar energy investment in Indonesia has doubled in 2021?

Alvin Putra Siswinugraha, Lead Author of ISEO 2025 and IESR's Electricity and Renewable Energy Analyst, revealed that solar energy investment in Indonesia has doubled, from USD 68 million in 2021 to USD 134 million in 2023.

What is Indonesia's Solar Energy Outlook 2025?

The Indonesia Solar Energy Outlook (ISEO) 2025 report highlights that solar energy growth in Indonesia has been slow compared to the targets outlined in PLN's National Energy General Plan and Electricity Supply Business Plan, with a total installed capacity of 718 MW as of August 2024.

Can solar energy be a strategy to meet Indonesia's energy goals?

Solar energy can be a strategy to meet this target," said Deon Arinaldo, Program Manager of Energy System Transformation, at the launch of the Indonesia Solar Energy Outlook 2025 study report - Breaking the Walls: The Future of Indonesia's Solar Energy and Energy Storage Innovations (15/10/2024).

Will Indonesia add more solar power by 2033?

According to IESR, Indonesia's state electricity company, PLN, plans to increase renewable energy generation by adding 7.9 GW of solar capacity by 2033. Additionally, policy changes from the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources are expected to add over 5 GW of rooftop solar capacity within five years.

What is Indonesia's potential for solar energy?

Indonesia's technical potential for solar ranges from 3,300 GW to 20,000 GW, according to IESR estimates, while the country's long-term energy policy targets up to 108.7 GW of solar by 2060. If implemented effectively, the program could redefine Indonesia's energy landscape and serve as a global benchmark for large-scale distributed renewables.

To date, nearly all solar energy project development in Indonesia has revolved around extending sustainable energy access to remote, off-grid communities by deploying solar home systems (SHS) or solar-plus-storage micro- or mini-grids.

That's why people who calculate solar power return on investment carefully often find solar to out-return traditional investments in terms of both stability and predictability. ...
