How much does solar cost in Florida?

With just one tax credit, the average effective cost of solar panels can drop from \$34,960 to a much more reasonable \$24,472. The average system price of solar in Florida is above the national average, and the incentives aren't as appealing as they are in many other states -- likely because the state has no Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) goal.
