How much battery energy storage capacity is available in India?

Between 2022 and May 2025, India auctioned approximately 12.8 GWh of battery energy storage system (BESS) capacity for both hybrid and standalone applications. However, only about 219 MWh of BESS capacity is reported to be operational, leaving a large pipeline of projects under construction.

What is the storage potential of EV batteries in India?

Estimation of storage potential based on EV and RE growth scenarios in India. Utilization of battery degradation models to estimate EV battery capacity fade. The first life of popular Li-ion batteries in EV applications found to be 3.5 to 7 years. Storage potential in year 2038 found to range from 1300 to 1870 GWh in various scenarios.
