Why is electricity expensive in Kosovo?

Usually, in Kosovo the imported energy is much more expensive than export. This is because Kosovo imports energy one day before needed, in the other hand energy is exported during the night when the demands are under generating level. Imports and exports have a negative impact for electrical energy price.

What percentage of electricity is generated by coal in Kosovo?

Coal accounted for 91% of electricity generation, with the remaining 9% derived from renewable energy sources, predominantly wind energy. Kosovo has been working on diversifying its energy mix and increasing the share of renewable energy sources to reduce dependency on conventional fossil fuels.

What is the role of energy transformation in Kosovo?

How is energy used in Kosovo? Total energy supply (TES) includes all the energy produced in or imported to a country, minus that which is exported or stored. It represents all the energy required to supply end users in the country.

What is the energy strategy for Kosovo?

The Kosovo energy strategy includes increasing RES capacity to 35% of electricity consumption by 2031. Aiming for 600 MW wind, 600 MW solar PV, 20 MW biomass & at least 100 MW of prosumer capacity, to reach a total installed RES capacity of 1600 MW by 2031. Lignite exploitation in Kosovo started in 1922.

How much CO₂ does Kosovo emit a year?

Greenhouse gas emissions in Kosovo are estimated around 10.5 million tons of CO₂ equivalent. There are challenges associated with increasing the share of renewable energy in the country's energy mix. Some of the challenges include: Kosovo has historically relied heavily on coal for its energy needs.

What if Kosovo used its full technical potential?

As we can see, if Kosovo would use its entire technical potential, it would increase the generating power by 126%. Greenhouse gas emissions in Kosovo are estimated around 10.5 million tons of CO₂ equivalent. There are challenges associated with increasing the share of renewable energy in the country's energy mix.
