Does SRP have a solar and battery energy storage project?

SRP has contracted with NextEra Energy Resources for additional Arizona-based solar and battery energy storage projects. These include the Sonoran Energy Center, an approximately 260-MW solar facility with the ability to charge a 1 gigawatt-hour battery energy storage system.

What does SRP stand for?

SRP is leading Western electric utilities in large-scale battery investments. Salt River Project(SRP) and NextEra Energy Resources,LLC have officially commissioned a 100-megawatt (MW) battery energy storage system to store the energy produced by the operating Saint Solar Energy Center in Coolidge,Arizona.

What is SRP solar & how does it work?

SRP solar plans allow customers to offset a portion of their monthly energy bill by generating some of their own power. A common misconception is that rooftop solar customers won't receive an SRP bill of any kind. While that isn't true, your monthly bill can be lower with solar generation than it would be without.

Is SRP a good battery company?

SRP is leading Western electric utilities in large-scale battery investments. SRP's total battery storage online by 2024 equates to nearly10% of the current battery storage in the entire U.S.

How much solar energy will SRP add to its portfolio?

SRP also plans to add 7,000 MWof new renewable resources,which includes 6,000 MW of new,large-scale solar resources by 2035. This is enough solar energy to power more than 1.3 million average-sized homes and will triple SRP's current extensive portfolio of solar resources scheduled to come online by the end of 2025.

How many solar battery projects does SRP have?

SRP currently has three battery projects operatingand five others under construction.\nFor perspective,it took SRP 120 years to develop the generation capacity we have today,
