What is Suzhou Industrial Park (SIP)?

The Suzhou Industrial Park (SIP) is the largest cooperative project between the Chinese and the Singaporean government. It is beside Jinji Lake, which lies to the east of the Suzhou Old City.

Where is Suzhou Industrial Park located?

The Suzhou Industrial Park () is a major development zone located in Suzhou, Jiangsu, China. It was formally established in February 1994 as part of China's broader reform and opening up efforts under a bilateral agreement between the Chinese and Singaporean governments.

Who is the developer of Suzhou Industrial Park?

CSSD (China-Singapore Suzhou Development Group Co., Ltd.), a joint venture between SIPC (Suzhou Industrial Park Co., Ltd. i.e. Chinese Consortium) and SSTD (Singapore- Suzhou Township Development Pte Ltd. i.e. Singaporean Consortium), is the primary developer of Suzhou Industrial Park.

What happened to Suzhou Industrial Park?

Poor Suzhou Industrial Park, being the smaller neighbour of its humongous and glamorous neighbour, Shanghai (which was just a 30-min train ride away), was often neglected.

Is Suzhou Industrial Park a shady place?

Far from being the dirtier, lowly, industrial twin of Shanghai, Suzhou Industrial Park had wide tree-lined avenues, free from potholes and rubbish. There was no shady characters in sight. Instead, one sees families strolling by every now and then.
