What does NPB stand for in baseball?

The trophy awarded to the winner of the Japan Series, see at the Japanese Baseball Hall of Fame (photo: Brad Smith) Since 1950, Nippon Professional Baseball (NPB) has been the highest level of baseball in Japan. The league comprises 12 teams divided into two circuits - the Pacific League and Central League.

How does NPB work?

In the NPB, the team with the best record from each league is crowned the pennant winner, but they don't automatically make it to the Japan Series championship. Instead, they receive a bye while the 2 and 3 seeded teams face off in a best of 3 game playoff series where all the games are played at the 2 seed's home stadium.

Is NPB a professional sports league?

NPB was the only professional sports league in Japan until the foundation of the J.League in 1993. It is the eleventh-wealthiest professional sport league by revenue in the world, and the second-wealthiest baseball league, behind Major League Baseball (MLB); it is also the wealthiest sports league in Asia.

How many teams does NPB have?

NPB comprises twelve teams divided equally in two leagues, the Central League and the Pacific League, a format which it has largely kept since 1957.

What is Nippon Professional Baseball (NPB)?

Since 1950, Nippon Professional Baseball (NPB) has been the highest level of baseball in Japan. The league comprises 12 teams divided into two circuits - the Pacific League and Central League. Certain aspects of NPB are unique to Japan, such as: 143 regular-season games (that begin in late March or early April, and end in early October).

Does the NPB have a DH?

Designated Hitter - Just like the MLB - until a few years ago - the NPB also has the weird half/half DH rule. The Pacific League uses the DH, while the Central League does not have a DH. The only exception is during interleague games when the Pacific League team is the home team.

The NPB rules are essentially those of the American Major League Baseball (MLB), but technical elements are slightly different. MLB uses a standardized ball manufactured by Rawlings. Its seams are rather flat, and it is prepared for use by rubbing it with a special mud to reduce the slipperiness of the new leather. For a long period there was no standard ball in NPB, but currently a standard ball manufactured ...
